Boat wakes dissipate quickly and have little impact on shoreline erosion compared to wind-driven waves.



Wake boats operating in 10 feet of water while in surf-mode have no impact on waters' bottoms.



Sedimentation caused by boat traffic or wind-driven waves is significantly less than the amount of sedimentation that flows naturally through lakes' watersheds.



Boat wakes can increase oxygenation, which is beneficial for aquatic ecosystems.



The wake created by a wake boat in surf-mode dissipates faster than the wake created by a typical boat.
